4.1	<p>PdS agreed to talk to James Carter re the website on Friday evening. PdS and SJR had prepared example pdfs for two sites. JMcN pointed out that they failed to mention whether the sites were publicly accessible or not. All agreed that this was essential. PdS to modify the existing three documents (including SJR's Jumbles) and email copies to James. JMcN agreed to produce pdfs for a few more sites.</p> <p>The model for the pdfs is:            First page: Name and brief details of the site and accessibility followed by a map.            Further pages: Any appropriate sketches, maps or stratigraphic logs plus a few photographs, with captions, of interesting features of the site. If the site is large the approximate location of where the photos were taken will be marked on the map.</p>	PdS, JMcN

SJR to communicate responses to Nik.</p> <p>The Conder Head LGS, L18, is a large geomorphological feature and Nik was reluctant to show it full size on the LCC map. It was agreed that a suitably sized dot on the map would be sufficient.</p> <p>Snipe Rake has now been given two references, BU06 and HO1 because it is in two separate local authority areas.</p> <p>Cockersand Abbey farm Shap granite erratic won't be designated an LGS. C3 will be renamed 'Black Brook, White Coppice and Stronstrey bank'.</p> <p>BU1, Copy Clough has been denotified, see notes of meeting 5 Feb 2019.</p> <p>Grindleton Dyke has already been denotified.</p>	SJR
